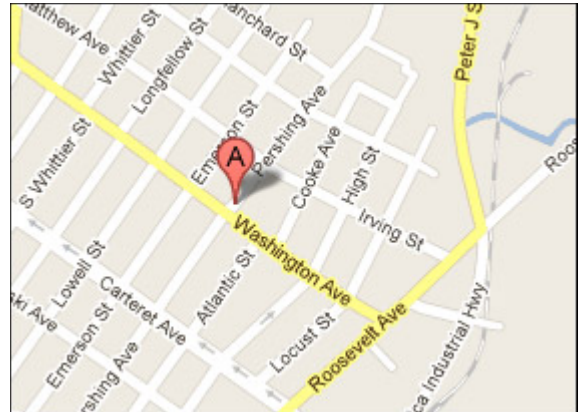
Church History
